Theme	Details
Letters・Vocabulary	To learn the knowledge of letters, vocabulary to do something in Japanese.
Grammar・Reading	To acquire the grammatical knowledge and the ability to understand long sentences.
Listening	To acquire the ability of hearing and understanding.

【Test Certification Standard】

N2	The ability to understand Japanese used in everyday situations, and in a variety of circumstances to a certain degree.	
Reading	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One is able to read materials written clearly on a variety of topics, such as articles and commentaries in newspapers and magazines as well as simple critiques, and comprehend their contents. • One is also able to read written materials on general topics and follow their narratives as well as understand the intent of the writers. 	
Listening	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One is able to comprehend orally presented materials such as coherent conversations and news reports, spoken at nearly natural speed in everyday situations as well as in a variety of settings, and is able to follow their ideas and comprehend their contents. One is also able to understand the relationships among the people involved and the essential points of the presented materials. 	

N3	The ability to understand Japanese used in everyday situations to a certain degree.	
Reading	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One is able to read and understand written materials with specific contents concerning everyday topics. • One is also able to grasp summary information such as newspaper headlines. • In addition, one is also able to read slightly difficult writings encountered in everyday situations and understand the main points of the content if some alternative phrases are available to aid one’s understanding. 	
Listening	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • One is able to listen and comprehend coherent conversations in everyday situations, spoken at near-natural speed, and is generally able to follow their contents as well as grasp the relationships among the people involved.
